CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

A	Exhibits are to be in a clean condition.
B	Exhibitors are to write their name on the back of the entry ticket and attach it to the back of their entry.
C	Please protect your frames with adequate packing as no responsibility will be taken.
D	Exhibits may be left at the show office in Welcome Street up until the Friday before the Show or brought to the main pavilion at the showground on Monday between 8.30am and 9.30 am.
E	No late entries will be accepted after 9.30am on the Monday.
F	Exhibits in Class M must be new and not worn and not previously exhibited at a Parkes Show.
G	Exhibits must be a bonafide work of the Exhibitor.
H	Exhibitors forwarding lists should ensure both exhibit and entry numbers correspond.
I	Exhibitors must produce their duplicate ticket when collecting exhibits after 8pm on Wednesday night.
J	If an exhibit is entered in the wrong section, the Judge and Chief Steward have the power to transfer the exhibit to the correct section.
K	Pointscore: Champion 3, Reserve 2, 1st 3, 2nd 2. In the event of a tie, a countback will be conducted. Champion 1st Place, Reserve 2nd Place in that order, if the score is still deadlocked a ballot will be conducted.
L	A garment is wearable clothing, and an article is not a garment and therefore not wearable.
M	Handmade labels with names must be covered.
