CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

A	Entries close 5pm Friday at the show office or 10am Saturday at the Arts & Craft pavilion. Labelled murals from schools will be collected on Friday before the show.
B	Judging takes place on Saturday 12pm.
C	All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor and executed in the 12 months preceding the show.
D	All Open entries must be mounted with a cord securely attached ready for hanging. Stewards are not bound to exhibit a work not ready for hanging.
E	All possible care will be taken of entries, but no responsibility is accepted by the Parkes Show for loss or damage in transit or during the show.
F	All exhibitors must note on the back of each exhibit, their name, phone number, class, section, and name of school for the Junior Section in which the exhibit is to be entered.
G	Stewards are not bound to exhibit every entry, and may be subject to space considerations, but all entries will be viewed by the judge. Junior exhibits are judged by a panel of local artists who are also stewards in the Art Section.
H	No item is to be removed before the close of the exhibition being 7pm Wednesday.
I	Exhibits can be collected between 7-8.30 pm Wednesday or between 10am-12 noon on Thursday from the Arts & Craft pavilion. Uncollected entries if properly labelled will be returned to the schools, or other exhibits not collected will be returned to the show office with items & prize money to be collected no later than 15th September.
J	A novice is an exhibitor who has not previously won in that section at the Parkes Show. Teachers or anyone who has instructed in this medium are not considered eligible to enter the novice section.
K	If an Art Judge considers an exhibit has been entered in the wrong section, the Judge has the power to enter the exhibit into a suitable section.
L	Stewards retain the right to reject any entry which is, in their opinion offensive or inappropriate.
M	Mural size should not exceed 1260mm x 300mm and can be in any medium or mixed media and should be capable of being hung on a wall by drawing pins and should be on paper or cardboard but not wood or other heavy backing.

CLASS N OPEN

1. Portrait of a person, painting (medium must be applied with a brush or palette knife) using oil, watercolour, gouache, tempura or acrylic (or mixed media using these listed media).
2. Portrait or figure of a person - drawing using graphite, pencil, charcoal, conte, pen and ink, felt pen, pastel, oil pastel, crayon (or mixed media using these listed media).
3. Rural subject or rural scene, painting or drawing, using any one of the media listed in 1 & 2 above.
4. Landscape painting or drawing, using media listed in 1 & 2 above. \$50 Sponsor: **Parkes Painting Group**
5. Seascape, painting or drawing, using any media listed in 1 & 2 above. \$50 Sponsor: **Parkes Painting Group**
6. Australian flora and/or fauna, using any medium. \$30 donated in memory of **J W Watson**

7. Indigenous art by indigenous artists any subject, any medium or combination of mixed media.
8. Abstract or contemporary, any medium.
9. Watercolour, any subject (open) \$50 Sponsor: **Brian & Carole Lowe**
10. Drawing, any subject, using any media listed in 2 above.
11. Painting any subject (novice). Open only to exhibitors who have not won a prize at Parkes Show, using any one of the media listed in 1 above \$50 Sponsor: **Allan Wright**
12. Miniature Painting (6" x 4" maximum painting size) using any medium \$40 Sponsor: **Tim & Gai Baker**
13. Still life, painting or drawing using any one of the media listed in 1 & 2 above.
14. Pastel, any subject. \$50 Sponsor: **Parkes Painting Group**
15. Painting in acrylic, any subject \$50 Sponsor: **Parkes Painting Group**
16. Painting in mixed media, any subject.
17. Painting in oil or oil pastel any subject.
18. Local Parkes building or street scene using media in 1 & 2 above. \$50 Sponsor: **Parkes Shire Council.**
19. Black and white, any subject, any medium (or mixed media), (cannot be eligible for drawing).
